

THE TEN PLAGUES

The ten plagues spoken of in the book of Exodus are greatly magnified when we compare them to the plagues found in the Book of Revelation. But, as we read in our bible, the purpose of these plagues are the same: to judge the false gods of this world. The people of Mitzrayim (Egypt) had many gods that governed different aspects of their lives and their environment.




THE EXODUS/REVELATION CONNECTION

- In the future when YHWH pours out His plagues upon the Earth, He will be judging the mighty ones, the false gods of this world that people have given themselves over to - instead of giving themselves to the one and only God, the God of Avraham, Yitzchak, and Yaakov... the God of Yisra'el.
- Exodus 12:12 states, "For that night, I will pass through the land of Egypt and kill all the firstborn in the land of Mitzrayim, both men and animals; and I will execute judgment against all the gods of Mitzrayim; I am Yahweh."

- 1. Blood- the Egyptians believed that since the moon controls the tides of the ocean that it had power over the water. Therefore Yahweh brought the plague of blood to show that there is a greater power than the moon that controls the water.
- 2. Frogs- the Egyptians believed that Mercury was responsible for controlling all living things in the water. Therefore again Yahweh caused frogs to come out of the water and jump into the ovens and into the Egyptian's stomachs, to prove that there is a greater power than Mercury.
- 3. Lice- Venus is supposed to manipulate all beauty in the world. Yahweh thus brought lice, once of the most disgusting creatures, over Egypt to show that He is the master over all including the beauty of the world.
- 4. Wild animals- they believed that the sun had a controlling power on those animals that lived in the desert where the sun shines brightly. However, Yahweh proved otherwise by causing many wild animals to leave their habitats and enter Egyptians cities. Thus, Yahweh once again showed that he has the power to control the instincts of all animals and where they are to live.
- 5. Plague on the Animals- The Egyptians believed that Mars was responsible for blood and body warmth. The Yalkut Me'am Loez explains that during this plague all body heat was lost in the animals due to cold air therefore causing them to die. Yahweh showed that he is the once who controls health and warmth.

- 6. Boils- it was believed that <u>Jupiter</u> was responsible in the balance of human body fluids. However, the boils caused an extreme imbalance of fluids on the skin hence causing a tremendous amount of pain to the Egyptians.
- 7. Hail- The Egyptians believed that there were gods that worked with <u>Saturn</u> that control all things that relate to ice, snow, or cold. However, when Yahweh brought down a hail that contained fire from within, He proved that there were no such gods that existed.
- 8. Locusts- the Zodiac was supposed to have influence on all the animals and control where they wander. However, Yahweh showed that He is more powerful than the Zodiac and allowed multitudes of locusts to cross Egypt's border and consume everything that the hail had left over.
- 9. Darkness- Day and night was believed to be controlled through a power called the Outer Sphere. Yahweh, on the other hand, proved that it is He who controls when it is day or night. Thus He brought seven days of darkness upon Egypt.
- 10. Death of the First Born- The intellectual sphere was believed to bless all first-born children at birth giving them special advantages through a direct link with this sphere. However Yahweh confirmed that He is the one and only who controls life and the well-being of any first born child and thus killed all first-born Egyptian people and animals.



LETS DISCOVER THE SIMILARITIES AND CONNECTION BETWEEN THE 10 PLAGUES OF EGYPT AND THE PLAGUES IN REVELATIONS


1: THE PLAGUE OF BLOOD

- When Yahweh was about to deliver His people from Egypt, one of the signs was a plague in which water was turned into blood. The Nile was a god to the Egyptians and a chief source of their economic prosperity.
- Moshe and Aaron did just as Yahweh had commanded. He raised his staff in the presence of Pharaoh and his officials and struck the water of the Nile, and all the water was changed into blood. The fish in the Nile died, and the river smelled so bad that the Egyptians could not drink its water.



Hapi- Egyptian God of the Nile

Seven days the water throughout all the land of Egypt remained in this state, unsuitable for drinking, the perfect length of time to demonstrate that the YHWH was superior to all the other Gods of Egypt.



PROPHET JOEL

Yo'el (Joel) 2:28-31 as it says, "After this, I will pour out my Spirit on all humanity. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions; and also on male and female slaves in those days I will pour out my Spirit. I will show wonders in the sky and on earth - blood, fire and columns of smoke. The sun will be turned into darkness and the moon into blood before the coming of the great and terrible Day of Yahweh".





THE TWO WITNESSES

The book of Revelation speaks of two witnesses who will confirm God's testimony before the people of the Earth before the end. No Biblical covenant is completed without the shedding of blood. In Revelation 11:6 we read, "They have the authority to shut up the sky, so that no rain falls during the period of their prophesying; also they have the authority to turn the waters into blood and to strike the earth with every kind of plague as often as they want."





REVELATIONS 16:3-6

- In Revelation 8:8 we begin reading about this when it says, "The second angel sounded his shofar, and what looked like an enormous blazing mountain was hurled into the sea. A third of the sea turned to blood". Revelation chapter 16:3-6 states, "The second one poured out his bowl into the sea, and it became like the blood of a dead person, and every living thing in the sea died. The third one poured out his bowl into the rivers and springs of water, and they turned to blood.
- Then I heard the angel of the waters say, "O HaKadosh (Holy One), the One who is and was, you are just in these judgments of yours. They poured out the blood of your people and your prophets, so you have made them drink blood. They deserve it!"




JUDGEMENT ON THE SABBATH DAY

The second plague is described in Exodus 8:1-7. An interval of "seven days" (7:25) separated this second plague from the first. Full opportunity was thus given to Pharaoh to repent, before Yah acted in judgment again. In view of the fact that the Flood commenced on the seventh day (see Genesis 7:10 margin), that is, the holy Sabbath, the conclusion is highly probable that each of these first two plagues were sent upon Egypt on the Sabbath day, as a Divine judgment for the Egyptians' desecration of it.

2: THE PLAGUE OF FROGS

Exodus 8:1-4, Then YHWH said to Moshe, "Go to Pharaoh and say to him, 'Thus says the Lord, "Let My people go, that they may serve Me. "But if you refuse to let them go, behold, I will smite your whole territory with frogs. "And the Nile will swarm with frogs, which will come up and gó into your house and into your bedroom and on your bed, and into the houses of your servants and on your people, and into your ovens and into your kneading bowls. "So the frogs will come up on you and your people and all your servants."



Heket- Egyptian Goddess of Fertility, Water, Renewal

- From the greatest to the least, no one in Egypt escaped the plague of frogs.
- Pharaoh's magicians were able to bring more frogs in their attempt to imitate the power of YHWH, but only Moses was able to make the frogs go away. This was another attack on a famous Egyptian Goddess, Heket.



JUDGEMENT ON POLITICAL BABYLON

- The frogs were the small Nile frog, called *Dofda* in Egyptian also called *rana Mosaica*, or *Nilotica*. Frogs represent boastful croaking, pomposity, an air of superiority. Frog demons will come out of the mouths (for communication) of Satan, the Beast, and False Prophet of the Tribulation to gather the nations to the Battle of Armageddon (Revelation 16:13-14).
- The Plague of the Frogs represents the judgment of Political Babylon (the kings of the earth).

THE DRAGON, BEAST AND FALSE PROPHET

In Revelation 16:13-14 we read about a force that will cover the face of the Earth. It says, "And I saw coming out of the mouth of the dragon and out of the mouth of the beast and out of the mouth of the false prophet, three unclean spirits like frogs; for they are spirits of demons, performing signs, which go out to the kings of the world, to gather them together for the war of the great day of Yahweh, the Almighty". Perhaps these demonic spirits are compared to frogs as their power will cover the Earth as the frogs of Egypt covered the land."

3: PLAGUE OF GNATS/LICE

- Exodus 8:16-17 Then Yahweh said to Moshe, "Say to Aaron, 'Stretch out your staff and strike the dust of the earth, that it may become gnats through all the land of Egypt.' And they did so; and Aaron stretched out his hand with his staff, and struck the dust of the earth, and there were gnats on man and beast. All the dust of the earth became gnats through all the land of Egypt.
- The species of gnats was sciniphes, a species of gnat hardly visible yet causing painful irritation. Gnats, which swarm in the air.
- Exodus 8:18-19 And the magicians tried with their secret arts to bring forth gnats, but they could not; so there were gnats on man and beast. Then the magicians said to Pharaoh, "This is the finger of G_d." But Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he did not listen to them, as the Lord had said. Having been put down, the magicians were impressed with the plague of gnats and called it "the finger of G_d."

EVERY KNEE WILL BOW AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HE IS THE ONLY G D.

The admission of the magicians on this occasion is noteworthy: "Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This is the finger of G_d" (8:19). These are their *last* recorded words. In the end they were obliged to acknowledge the hand of YHWH. So will it be in the last Great Day with the Devil himself, and with all his hosts and victims. They, too, will have to bow before the YHWH, and publicly confess the supremacy of the Almighty.


THE FINGER OF YAHWEH

Although the finger of Yah is associated with writing the Ten Commandments, creating the heavens, and casting out demons (Exodus) 31:18; Psalm 8:3; Luke 11:20), the magicians were unbelievers and were referring to one of their demon-gods and not Jehovah-Elohim. They were saying that the gnats were the work of a powerful god, and therefore, they could not duplicate it. In spite of the gnats, however, Pharaoh's heart was still hardened. The word for hardened is chazaq, which stressed the strength, or firmness of Pharaoh's convictions against Yah.



Geb- Egyptian God of the Earth

- The very dust that was referred to in the creation process of man is now used to plague men, as a reminder of his mortality and sin which both lead to death.
- Finally, the magicians of Pharaoh are humiliated, being unable to compete with this power that was so much greater than themselves and the powers that they had from their Egyptian gods and goddesses, and they profess, "this is the finger of G_d." This was the last plague that required Aaron's involvement, as the next set of three plagues are issued by the word of Moshe himself.




REVELATION 9:20

In a similar way Revelation 9:20 states, "The rest of mankind that were not killed by these plagues still did not repent of the work of their hands; they did not stop worshiping demons, and idols of gold, silver, bronze, stone and wood--idols that cannot see or hear or walk."


4: PLAGUE OF DOG FLIES

- **Exodus 8:20-23** Now Yahweh said to Moshe, "Rise early in the morning and present yourself before Pharaoh, as he comes out to the water, and say to him, 'Thus says YHWH, "Let My people go, that they may serve Me. "For if you will not let My people go, behold, I will send swarms of dog flies on you and on your servants and on your people and into your houses; and the houses of the Egyptians shall be full of swarms of dog flies, and also the ground on which they dwell.
- "But on that day I will set apart the land of Goshen, where My people are living, so that no swarms of dog flies will be there, in order that you may know that I, Yahweh, am in the midst of the land. "And I will put a deliverance between My people and your people. Tomorrow this sign shall occur."



Khepri- Egyptian God of creation, movement of the Sun, rebirth

Plagued by flies, Pharaoh tried a new tactic and begins bargaining with the YHWH, showing his desire to maintain power and authority over Yah. He tries to dictate the terms and conditions of the offer, telling them they may sacrifice but only "in the land" clearly not complying with the requested "three days journey" that the Lord required. Moses wouldn't budge, and Pharaoh relented allowing them to leave, but telling them not to "go very far."



THE ISRAELITES WERE EXEMPT FROM THE PLAGUES

■ The land of Goshen where Israel was living was exempted from the plague of dog flies. As the plagues judged the land of Egypt, Israel was delivered since it was on the right side of history. The word deliverance is literally *peduth*, which means redemption and not division as sometimes translated. As the justice of Yahweh judges evil, it delivers the Righteous.

Exodus 8:24

- "Then YHWH did so. And there came great swarms of dog flies into the house of Pharaoh and the houses of his servants and the land was destroyed because of the swarms of dog flies in all the land of Egypt."
- The fourth plague of dog flies swarmed all over Egypt. Dog flies are blood suckers, which were a menace to people and animals. The dog flies devoured the people and their bites left the people swollen and disfigured. The dog flies also laid their eggs in various places, such as fermenting vegetation, manure, and garbage. The eggs produced maggots, which destroyed the land.



SPIRITUAL BABYLON

The word dog flies is the Hebrew `arobh, which means mixture. The dog flies of Egypt have been described as worse than the gnats. The dog flies bite people and even attach themselves to the eyelids. The dog flies, like the gnats were associated with the air, and, therefore Spiritual Babylon (the demonic realm).



BAALZEBUB – LORD OF THE FLIES

- Later in history it will be revealed that Baalzebub (2 1:2-6 Kings, Matthew 10:25; Mark 3:22) is the lord of the flies. Whereas, dog flies represent demon powers of Spiritual Babylon, Baalzebub rules them. He also rules the world wide web.
- Baalzebub is symbolized by a spider. Thus, the Plagues of Egypt are important for learning the vocabulary for Spiritual Warfare.


PURPOSE OF THE PLAGUES

- Plagues 1, 4, and 7 are all introduced by a meeting between Moshe and Pharaoh "in the morning". These plagues also specifically state that the purpose of the plague is to know Yahweh. These plagues reduced the Egyptians in their own land to the insecure existence of strangers.
- Plagues 2, 5, and 8 all take place in Pharaoh's palace. These plagues robbed the Egyptians of their pride, their possession's, and their sense of superiority, reducing them to lowly submission.
- Plagues 3, 6, and 9 all take place without any warning being given to Pharaoh. These plagues imposed on the Egyptians actual physical suffering.

5: PLAGUE OF PESTILENCE

- Exodus 9:1-5 Then Yahweh said to Moses, "Go to Pharaoh and speak to him, 'Thus says the Lord, the G_d of the Hebrews, "Let My people go, that they may serve Me. "For if you refuse to let them go, and continue to hold them, behold, the hand of YHWH will come with a very severe murrain on your livestock which are in the field, on the horses, on the donkeys, on the camels, on the herds, and on the flocks. "But Yahweh will make a distinction between the livestock of Israel and the livestock of Egypt, so that nothing will die of all that belongs to the sons of Israel."
- And YHWH set a definite time, saying, "Tomorrow Yahweh will do this thing in the land."


Hathor-Egyptian Goddess of Love and Protection



■ Moshe once again demanded of Pharaoh, "Let my people go, that they may serve me", revealing also the next Egyptian plague to occur on the condition of continued disobedience to the request. This plague was given with an advanced warning, allowing a period of repentance to occur, which goes unheeded. This plague affected the Egyptian by creating a huge economic disaster, in areas of transportation, military supplies, farming, and economic goods that were produced by these livestock. Still Pharaohs heart remained hard and he would not listen to the Lord but remained faith to the Egyptian gods and goddesses.

- The fifth plague, murrain (pronounced mür'_ün, ü as in further), is the Hebrew deber, which means murrain, or cattle-plague. The word is derived from an Arabic word which means departure or death.
- Murrain is also called rinderpest, which is a highly contagious virus infection of livestock. The murrain would infect the livestock of Egypt but not the livestock of Israel. Here again the selective judgment of YHWH, cursed the Egyptians and delivered Israel. Even viruses are under the control of Elohim. A definite time was set for the beginning of the murrain to distinguish it from an incidental outbreak of the pestilence, which was known to occur periodically.
- The murrain infected the cattle in Egypt, which were considered sacred.




Revelation 6:8

- In addition to the killing with the sword and with the wild beasts of the Earth, the pale rider will also release pestilence upon the Earth.




6: THE PLAGUE OF BOILS

- The sixth plague of boils was a skin disease. The sixth plague, like the third, was not announced beforehand to Pharaoh.
- **Exodus 9:8-9** Then the Lord said to Moshe and Aaron, "Take for yourselves handfuls of soot from a kiln, and let Moshe throw it toward the sky in the sight of Pharaoh. "And it will become fine dust over all the land of Egypt, and will become boils breaking out with sores on man and beast through all the land of Egypt."
- Soot also causes the skin to be dirty, which symbolizes spiritual uncleanness.



Isis- Egyptian Goddess of Medicine and Peace



Cleanliness being paramount in the Egyptian society, this plague pronounces the people "unclean." The magicians who have been seen throughout the previous plagues are unable to perform ceremonially rituals to their Egyptian Gods and Goddesses in this unclean state, not allowing them to even stand before Pharaoh; they are seen in the scriptural account no more. It is great to notice the contrast shown as Moses and Aaron are the only ones left standing in front of Pharaoh, with the "One True G_d" as their support.

PEOPLE WHO SERVE THE BEAST AFFLICTED WITH LOATHSOME SORES


- Likewise, in Revelation 16:1-2 we read, "Then I heard a loud voice from the temple, saying to the seven Angels, "Go and pour out on the Earth the seven bowls of the wrath of God." So the first Angel went and poured out his bowl on the Earth; and it became a loathsome and malignant sore on the people who had the mark of the beast and who worshipped his image".
- There is an interesting connection between the plague that is described in Revelation and to what we saw in Exodus. It says that they could not stand before Moshe (Moses). In Judaism and in the scriptures Moshe represented the Torah and the covenant of Yisra'el's G_d.

FOLLOWING THE TORAH IS THE MARK OF YAH ON YOUR FOREHEAD


In Revelation 16:1-2 it says that those whom had the mark of beast also fell before this plague. In Hebrew thought the word for "mark" is the Hebrew word "tav", which is also symbolic for covenant. Those whom made a covenant with the Man of Lawlessness, the Anti-Messiah, turned their back on the covenant of YHWH. Those who will take hold of Yah's covenant, His Torah, will also receive a mark on their forehead symbolizing that they are in covenant with Him.

Deuteronomy 6:6-9

- These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.
- IF YOU LOVE ME KEEP MY COMMANDMENTS SAYS YHWH.

THE SEAL ON THE FOREHEAD

- Revelation 9:4 states, "And it was said to them that they should not harm the grass of the earth, nor every green thing, nor every tree, except only the men who do not have the seal of YHWH on their foreheads".
- Revelation 14:12 describes the men whom do have the seal of YHWH on their foreheads. It says, "Here is the patience of the holy ones, those who keep the commandments of YAH, and the faith of Yahshua".
- Therefore, those whom are affected by the plague of boils (along with the rest of the plagues) will also be those whom will not stand with Yahweh and His son.

FOLLOWING THE TORAH IS YOUR PROTECTION FROM PLAGUES

- The Torah is clear that those whom make it their lifestyle to transgress it will eventually experience the plagues of Egypt.
- YHWH tells us this in Deuteronomy 28:58-61; "If you will not observe and obey all the words of this Torah that are written in this book, so that you will fear this glorious and awesome name, HaShem your G_D; then HaShem will strike down you and your descendants with extraordinary plagues and severe sicknesses that go on and on. He will bring back upon you all the diseases the Egyptians had, which you were in dread of; and they will cling to you. Not only that, but HaShem will bring upon you all the sicknesses and plagues that are not written in this book of the Torah -until you are destroyed".
- And, after these plagues we see once again a theme echoed throughout the ten plagues of Egypt as it says in Revelation 16:11, "Yet they cursed the YHWH of heaven because of their pains and sores, and did not turn from their sinful deeds".





Yahweh says ""Anyone who isn't with me opposes me, and anyone who isn't working with me is actually working against me.

- Not only does Yahweh separate between the Israelites and the Egyptians (Wild Animals) and between the cattle of the Israelites and the cattle of the Egyptians (Cattle Disease), but this time He also separates between those whom Pharaoh once claimed were the ones with power "on his side" opposing Yahweh, and between Moshe and Aaron. Thus, Pharaoh is convinced that there is a G-d and that He is "in the land."
